#### **OVERVIEW**

Jay Moeller is the founder and overseer of the School for Kingdom Advancement as well as KRC. Jay is an apostolic father who jumpstarts leaders into their purpose by establishing their identity, engraining, and securing a Kingdom 1st mindset and equipping them for transformation. His heart burns to raise up Kingdom sons and daughters who will become fathers and mothers that raise up generations to expand the Kingdom into the earth. This will result in lives and cities being transformed as the culture of Heaven becomes the culture on the Earth. He has served as the Senior Pastor for Legacy Church in New Braunfels, TX since 2007.

Part of this call was to establish a regional training and equipping center/hub that would provide a platform for five-fold leaders to equip, empower and deploy believers into the mountains or spheres of influence they are called to impact. Ephesians 4:11-16 describes how Jesus gave gifts to the church in the form of apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors, and teachers. Their responsibility is to equip the saints (believers) for the work of ministry (both inside and out of the church) as well as help the whole body grow into the full maturity of Jesus. This work continues today.

In 2020, Jay along with the leadership of Legacy Church laid the foundation for the Kingdom Resource Center or KRC which is a separate entity from any church, including Legacy. The purpose for this is to provide a neutral place for believers throughout the region to be trained and equipped without giving up their local church family. A church leader can feel confident that anyone they send to a KRC course will not only be trained up well but will become even more effective in their church home. Long term, KRC will host and/or promote a variety of both in-person and virtual schools, intensives, and masterclasses. The School for Kingdom Advancement is one of these schools.

The main goal of SKA is primarily aimed at three things:

- Establish a clear foundation for what "Seeking First the Kingdom of God" looks like. This is regardless of someone's specific gifts or calling. It is the *First Priority* that everything is built upon.
- Engrain within you a Kingdom First framework for mindsets, identity, revival, the Bible, church, ministry, character, and more. How you think will impact how you live. Who you think you are will determine what you are capable of. We will bring you into alignment with how God thinks and who He is. This includes equipping you to operate wholeheartedly in every part of your life with the character to match.
- Equip and empower you to bring transformation by advancing the Kingdom into your sphere of influence. God lives in you to transform you. He works through you to transform the world around you. This is more than just "doing" ministry but instead "re-presenting" the image of a

good Father to a world desperately in need of one. This looks like helping orphans become trusted sons and daughters who develop into trusted fathers and mothers in the Kingdom while also providing practical solutions.

Who is this school for? The beauty of SKA is that it is designed to expand your growth, no matter where you're at in your journey or the scope of your calling. It may be your first time taking a ministry school of any kind beyond church discipleship programs. It may be your first or next step before committing to a multiyear school like BSSM, Seminary, ETC. Maybe your pastor or church leader is wanting to develop you into a leadership role. You may already be a seasoned leader ready for more. You may just be hungry and are looking to grow in your understanding of God. SKA will equip you with a framework that allows you to accelerate your success.

### FEE BREAKDOWN

**Deposit:** \$133 due at registration (Goes towards tuition. Non-Refundable.)

**Tuition Total:** \$633 (Includes deposit)

Why an odd number? The answer is both practical and prophetic. Matthew 6:33 is foundational to our school and to understanding the Kingdom. This is an investment in yourself as you pursue the Kingdom.

For Married Couples attending SKA: Tuition-\$1200 (\$100 deposit per person still applies)

Payments: After acceptance, all payments are non-refundable. See below for payment options:

- 1) Pay full balance at time of registration.
- 2) After the initial \$133 deposit with your application, you can break the remainder of your tuition up to a maximum of 4 additional payments of \$125 each. Additional payments are due the first Sunday of each month. Balance will be do no later than Sunday, May 5th.
- 3) If for any reason you addition time, please communicate directly with Jay Moeller.

**NOTE:** Payments are designed to help those in need of assistance. If you have the ability, please pay in full sooner.

A list will be provided for you to purchase on your own. There will be a few required local conferences throughout the year for you to attend. Most of these are free but a few may have a registration fee attached. Finally, you will be required to receive a *HeartSync* session. *HeartSync* is an inner healing modality. The general fee is \$150 per session. We will provide you with contact information to schedule your *HeartSync*. This must be completed before the end of SKA in May.

# STEPS TO APPLY

- 1. Apply at <a href="https://www.legacynb.com/SKA">www.legacynb.com/SKA</a>
- 2. Pay \$133 deposit fee online at registration (included towards cost of tuition).
- 3. Send Pastoral and Personal Recommendation links to those who will be recommending you. After applying, you will receive the links via email. Please forward the links to those whom you want to recommend. Once they fill it out, the office receives it digitally. (Please note: Pastoral recommendation not needed for Legacy Church members. Only one personal recommendation).
- 4. On a case by case basis, we will schedule an appointment to connect with you and discuss any further questions regarding your application if they arise.
- 5. We will email you with an acceptance letter once everything has been reviewed. If for any reason, you are not accepted, we will refund the initial \$133 deposit.
- 6. Follow options to pay from above.

### CLASS TIME AND LOCATION

The School for Kingdom Advancement takes place over 4 months (18 sessions) as a practical Kingdom training school of ministry. On January 26-28, 2024, we will kick off SKA with a Weekend intensive that includes sessions Friday 7pm, Saturday, 9am-Noon, 2-4pm, 6-8pm, and Sunday 5-8pm. Graduation is on the third Sunday of May and will include a celebration dinner plus final assignment. Our regular class takes place at Legacy Church in New Braunfels, TX on Sunday evenings from 5pm-8pm. Please be prompt. During class, there will be times of teaching, group discussion, testimonies, activations.

### **ACTIVATION GROUP**

An important part of this process is small group interaction and discussion. These groups are designed for you to stay connected, process what is being taught, and activate it. One of our goals is not to replace any small groups our students are a part of within their local church. Instead, we built in interaction time every Sunday night. When you attend a conference, we ask that you sit together and process together while at the conference.

# **SERVICE**

Jesus came not to be served but to serve. Service is not a part of our identity but instead the outflow of who we are in Christ. We ask that as a ministry student that you are in some capacity serving your local church. Quarterly evaluation sheets from your ministry leader will be due on the Homework deadline.

### **ZOOMS WITH GUEST SPEAKERS**

SKA includes a Bi-weekly Guest Speaker Zoom on Wednesday nights. They are mandatory but will be recorded in case someone misses. These speakers are all five-fold fathers or mothers who carry specific callings, gifts and anointings that we want to impart to you. You will be asked to turn in a short summary of what spoke to you the most.

#### **HOMEWORK**

Homework is a mixture of book reports, conference reports, simple Review Questions from each lesson, as well as personal reflections. This will also include a Kingdom leader interview and report. You will be given a Student Workbook binder. The main purpose is to gauge your progress and engagement. Grades are Pass/Fail. We will record every session for you to review or to make up for an unavoidable absence. DO NOT share these recordings with anyone outside of SKA. A private Dropbox link will be sent via email every Tuesday with the previous Sunday's recordings.

### **BOOK REPORTS**

Four book reports are assigned each year. A sample report form will be provided in class. We are not looking for regurgitation of the information but instead how impacted your way of thinking, seeing and living. You will be asked to purchase a sixth book that will be used in class. See below for a list of the books that will be assigned:

- 1) When Heaven Invades Earth by Bill Johnson
- 2) Supernatural Ways of Royalty by Kris Vallotton
- 3) Love and Prophecy by Dan McCollam
- 4) Born For Significance by Bill Johnson
